ALL Teams: 10am – 3:30pm (20-30 minute break)

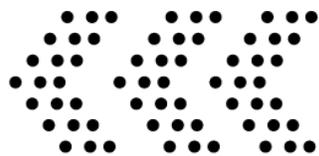
Tryout & Team Placement Timeline:

CEVA/USAV Junior Memberships



Tryout or Full memberships are OK for tryouts. If you have a tryout membership, it will expire and will need to be updated to "full" upon being placed on a team.



Athletes turning 18 before 8/31/25 should purchase the 18s player membership.



2024-2025 CEVA/USAV JUNIOR INDOOR MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

Credit card processing fees apply to all membership purchases. Additional fees may be charged by clubs for tryouts, practices, events, or other dues. Please contact clubs for specifics.

ALL MEMBERSHIP FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

CEVA Girls' Team Tryout Membership – Sept-Dec (All Ages) – \$15.00 Available 9/3/2024

This membership allows only for participation in region-sanctioned club volleyball tryouts and is upgradeable to a girl's full membership. It does not allow for participation in other region sanctioned events (practices, competitions, camps, clinics, etc.) or in USAV bid tournaments or USAV junior nationals.

CEVA Boys' Team Tryout Membership – Sept-Dec (All Ages) – \$15.00 Available 9/3/2024

This membership allows only for participation in region-sanctioned club volleyball tryouts **for a boys' team** and is upgradeable to a boy's full membership. It does not allow for participation in other region sanctioned events (practices, competitions, camps, clinics, etc.) or in USAV bid tournaments or USAV junior nationals.

**** CEVA Junior 17 & Under Player – \$65.00**

Available 9/3/2024

Allows for participation as a junior player in all USAV/CEVA sanctioned events.

**** CEVA Junior 18s Player – \$65.00**

Available 9/3/2024

Allows for participation in all junior USAV/CEVA sanctioned events for those who are 18 or older as of August 31, 2025. Participants must be Safesport trained prior to participation.

TEAM TRYOUTS

Day of tryouts tips:

- **Arrive 30 minutes early**
- **Have CEVA # and completed paperwork**
- **Wear comfortable athletic clothing – spandex/shorts, court shoes, kneepads**
- **Bring water bottle, necessary medications**
- **NO crop tops, loose jewelry, or fake nails**
- **15-18U will have a 20 minute break (bring a snack)**

- **Tryouts will be held in the West Gym. Participants are required to attend the session to be considered for a team. Tryouts are closed to the public and only those trying out for a team will be permitted in the gym.**

TEAM TRYOUTS

How are athletes evaluated at tryouts?

- **All skills**
- **Gameplay**
- **Sportsmanship**
- **Work ethic**
- **Coachability**

Players trying out for 15-18U will be asked what position(s) they want to play and they will be evaluated specifically on those positions.

We will also consider whether the athlete is willing to travel or participates in other sports during the club season. These factors will affect which team the athlete is eligible for.

- Athletic Membership dues + sport team fees
- Year-round commitment (doesn't end with the season)
- Looking for multi-year committed athletes
- Ages out when the athlete turns 18

2024-25 Teams Explained

Elite (National/Advanced)

- **Most competitive**
- **Practice 3x per week**
- **Must be committed to practice/tournament schedule (volleyball takes precedence over other activities)**
- **Participates in CEVA Power Leagues, Bid Tourney, Regionals, friendship tourneys, and national qualifiers.**
- **Travels out of state.**
- **Involves higher team fees than Premier and Select teams.**
- **No expectation of equal playing time.**



2024-25 Teams Explained

Premier (Regional/Intermediate)

- Practice 2-3x per week.
- Asked to make volleyball first priority, but can accommodate athletes with other activities.
- Participates in CEVA Power Leagues, Regionals, and friendship tourneys.
- 1-3 day tournaments
- Players will have fair playing time, but it is not equal amongst players.

2024-25 Teams Explained

Select (Local/Developmental)

- Practice 1-2x per week
- Best for beginning players who are looking to develop their skills.
- Best for athletes with multiple activities in their schedule. Athletes are still expected to communicate their schedules with coaches and give them plenty of notice of schedule conflicts.
- Participates in CEVA Power Leagues and Regionals.
- One day tournaments only.
- Higher focus on equal/fair playing time to develop all players equally.

Elite = 3x per week, Premier = 2-3x per week, Select = 1-2x per week.

December

- 15-18U teams participate in CEVA Kickoff tourney (1 day)
- 12-14U teams participate in MAC scrimmage & ref clinic
- Winter break (December 23rd – Jan 3) - Optional practices

January - May

- Power Leagues, Friendship Tourneys, Qualifiers
- Most teams participate in 2-3 tournaments per month
- Spring Break (Mar 24 – Mar 28) - Optional practices
- All teams end at Regionals (Apr 26-27, May 3-4)

Tournaments Explained

CEVA Power Leagues

- **1-2x per month**
- **All day (Sat or Sun)**
- **Regional ranking**
- **All teams participate in PL**
- **Ridgefield to Eugene**

CEVA Regionals

- **April 26-27 (12-14U)**
- **May 3-4 (15-18U)**
- **Marks end of the season**
- **PDX Expo/Olympus SC**

Friendship Tourneys

- **1-2x per month**
- **One-three days**
- **Primarily Premier & Elite teams**
- **Does not affect regional ranking**
- **Can be local or regional, depending on the team**

Qualifiers

- **Elite teams only**
- **National travel**

Team Fees

- **Billed over 5 monthly installments (Dec – Apr)**
- **80% of competitor**
- **Team fees help offset club costs, including:**
 - **Tournament entry fees**
 - **Coaches labor/travel**
 - **Equipment**
- **Team fees do NOT cover:**
 - **Airfare**
 - **Lodging**
 - **Transportation**
 - **Uniforms**
 - **CEVA Bid / GJNC tourneys**
 - **Overage from entry fees**

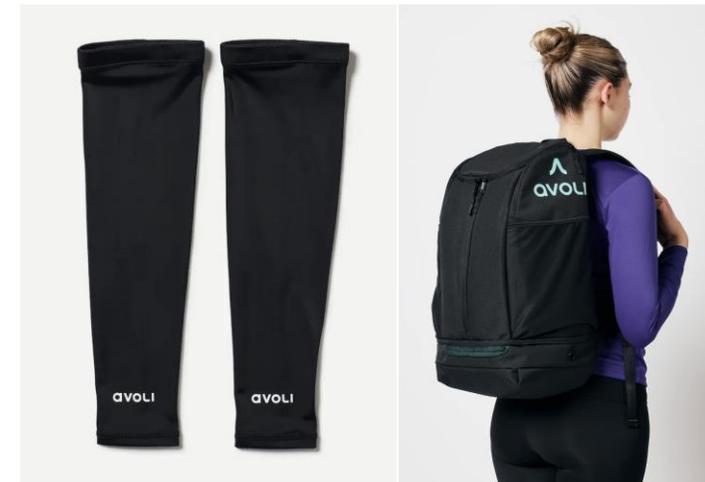
